EXHIBITORS' RULES/PUBLIC HEALTH & SAFETY

1. The show to commence at 8.30am prompt, unless due to adverse weather conditions the show committee will have to postpone.
2. The Show Committee have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone present.
3. Catalogue entries must be sent to the Section/General Secretary by **7th May 2011**. Late Entries will not be eligible to compete for Welsh Pony & Cob Society Bronze Medals in Section A, B, C, D and Welsh Ridden or **Part Bred unless they have been received and catalogued. SEE WP&CS Rule Book**
ENTRIES CLOSE 7th MAY 2011 – NO TELEPHONE ENTRIES RECEIVED AFTER 9.00PM
4. Any disputes or objections to be made in writing and lodged with the General Secretary on the day.
5. Each challenge trophy to be held for one year, unless it has been won outright. Winners will have to sign for the trophy, and return it to the show in good condition. The winner to compensate the show for any loss or damage.
6. All exhibits in the livestock section to be the bona fide property of the exhibitors, for at least two months prior to the show.
7. All exhibitors to be considered solely responsible for their exhibits at all times during the show.
8. Exhibits deemed unfit for presentation by the Judge or Veterinary Surgeon will be disqualified.
9. Exhibitors must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring
10. The Show Committee will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury arising from accidents or other causes.
11. All exhibits must be properly haltered and capable of being led quietly. Unruly animals will be ordered from the show field.
12. The Show Committee will not be held responsible for any irregularities within the schedules or catalogues.
13. Classes will be judged in the order that they appear in the catalogue. Nevertheless, if it appears necessary to alter the programme, this will be the Judge's/Stewards prerogative.
14. Exhibits not brought into the ring immediately, when called upon by the Stewards, will be disqualified.
15. Exhibitors must use Numbered cards so that they can readily be visible to the announcers, and as a reference to spectators.
16. No exhibit can leave and re-enter the ring after being presented for judging.
17. **DO NOT TIE HORSES/PONIES TO HORSE BOXES/LORRIES – THEY SHOULD BE BOXED AFTER COMPETING. DO NOT LEAVE HORSES UNATTENDED.**
18. If there are insufficient exhibits in a class, then the Chief Steward and General Secretary, may decide to cancel it entirely, or amalgamate it with another.

19. The Judge's decision will be final, with no exceptions. Exhibitors who undermine that decision will be ordered from the show field and all their prizes forfeited.
20. Weighting of sheep and measuring of horses will be at the Judge's discretion.
21. Exhibitors in the "Brood Mare" classes, not with their foals at foot, will be required to produce a veterinary certificate.
22. Any objections to the Judging must be forwarded in writing with a fee of £20 to the General Secretary within an hour of the class's completion.
