Class 4. British Show jumping Area 36 and The Pony Club Mini/Major Series 2011 with the generous support of Dyffryn Tywi Equine Clinic and Welsh Cottage Cakes.

Mini Section: Open to- Members of the Pony Club and Pony Associate or Pony Members of British Showjumping. Ponies are to be ridden by Pony Riders up to the end of the calendar year in which the rider reaches the age of 12, 14 and 16 respectively in accordance with rules 77.12/13 and 77.15.4. If a 'mini' is a member of both the Pony Club and British Show jumping, these riders will be deemed BS members for the series. A Pony or Pony Associate rider may only compete in one section either 'Mini' or 'Major' throughout the series. Pony riders to be 'partnered' with members of British Showjumping on registered horses.

Major section: Open to- Pony Associate, Associate and Full jumping members of British Showjumping on registered horses.

Table C. Both rounds against the clock. Mini rider to go first. Major rider to commence their round from a holding area when the pony lands over the last fence. Horse rider can complete the pony round if they have been eliminated. Should both riders get eliminated, both riders are deemed eliminated. 4 seconds added for a knock down.

Drawn partner. Drawn order. Ht of course: Pony 80-85cms. Horse 1m-1.05cms.
